### 3. Benefits for Institutional Members

According to ICCP statutes:

“INSTITUTIONAL MEMBERS: Institutional Members shall be those firms, institutions of higher learning, or other organisations interested in fostering the science of organic petrology. Institutional Members shall have the right to appoint up to 2 persons as their designated representatives. Such a person does not have to be a member, but it is encouraged. Member fees discounts will apply for up to 5 employees of the Institution willing to take part in ICCP activities and programs (e.g. accreditation and training). For individual ICCP members belonging to an Institutional member the rights of the individual member will be maintained without payment of the individual fee.

Institutional Members shall enjoy all the privileges of the Society except that they, or their representatives, shall not hold office or vote. Notwithstanding any of the above limitations, a designated representative of an Institutional Member, who is also an individual member, may so continue to exercise his/her membership rights and privileges on his/her own behalf.”

- *Reduced fee for ICCP training courses (30%)*
- *Discounts for accreditation*

### 4. Payment Options

Upon application, an invoice will be sent to the Institution with facilities to pay by credit card or direct bank transfer.
