## 2) The scheme for accreditation of petrographic analysis can start!

#### PREFACE:

At the ICCP meeting 1988 in Aachen it has been announced to start with a scheme of International Accreditation of Petrographic Analysis of Coal. This scheme is based on a suggestion of A.H.V. Smith. The organizer is R. Kutzner.

At the end of 1989 six sample sets were sent to all colleagues who have provided R. Kutzner with coal samples. After having received the results of 5 sample sets the first attempt for an evaluation of the results was made. The level of reflectance reproducibility obtained in this exercise was not sufficient to meet the requirements of the ISO classification. All results of reflectance were lower when samples had been repolished. It was decided for future work that crushed samples will be distributed for the reflectance analysis and members will prepare their own mounts.

For a successful exercise, a minimum of 20 participants in the accreditation exercise will be needed.

#### ACCREDITATION:

A number of views have been discussed about the question of the attribution of the certification - individual or laboratory, one analysis or more, single analysis or mean.

It was decided that all analysis for all experienced analysts should be returned and that the names for these analysts should be supplied to the organizer. These names will be used only for tracking performance of individuals. The data shall not be published in a form which will permit recognition of individual analysts or laboratories. Accreditation will be made to laboratories through the individuals. The laboratory accreditation level will be based on the grouped levels of the performance of individuals involved.

#### ORGANISATION:

30 sets of coal samples are available. Each set consists of 5 prepared blocks + 5 crushed samples of seam coals and costs
